



Reports for your Criminal Injuries Compensation Application

The following are suggestions for items to include in a report obtained to support your application. There may be additional items you wish to include and not all of the below may be relevant to your application. There is no prescribed format for a report or requirement as to what must be included.

01



The qualifications and experience of the person writing the report

02



The date you attended for assessment or the dates you attended for treatment

03



Your presenting complaints, including a description of the incident(s) which caused you injury

04



Any findings on examination (if a physical injury) or observations on interview (if a psychological injury)

05



The diagnosis of your condition

06



Confirmation, if appropriate; your condition was caused by the incident.

In the event there are any other factors which contributed to your condition these should be detailed, and if possible, the cause of your condition apportioned.

07



The impact of your condition on your ability to undertake:
(a) activities of daily living;
(b) recreation and social activities;
(c) family or household responsibilities; and
(d) employment

08



Your future treatment requirements, including an estimate of the likely costs

09



Your prognosis for recovery, including any permanent residual disabilities
